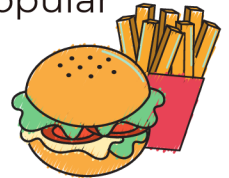

COURAGEOUS DOG STOPS TRAFFIC TO SAVE OWNER HAVING A MEDICAL EMERGENCY

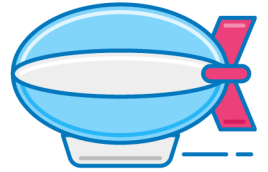

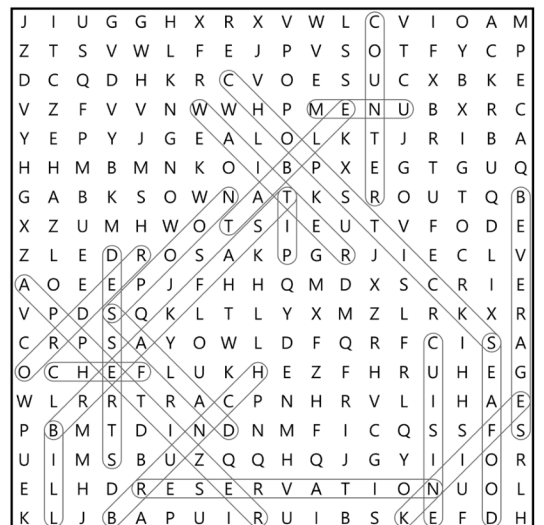

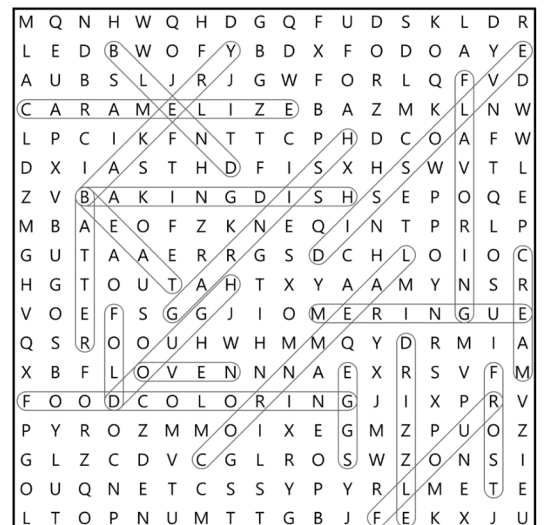

NASA'S SPACE HELICOPTER PERFORMS FLIGHT ON MARS
